Participants will be invited to develop robust policy recommendations and practical business ideas that will help create a vibrant and self-sufficient agri-food ecosystem in Malaysia.

The project will address key issues around the nation's staple food supply, including the creation of employment opportunities along the agri-food supply chain, increasing domestic agricultural investment, and improving the efficiency of land use. Through engagement with stakeholders and project partners, participants will be guided to develop solutions to reimagine the sector, regulate the conversion of farmland, transform agri-food into a more competitive and lucrative industry, and ultimately help Malaysia become a more sustainable and self-sufficient nation.
