India



Why India?

- USD 15b** Yearly nation-wide cost of consuming unsafe food and treating foodborne illnesses¹
- 86%** Street food vendors with non-compliant structural or sanitation setups²
- 100m** Indians suffer from foodborne diseases each year due to substandard hawker infrastructure³

India's street food sector is chronically under-supported - lacking sanitation, infrastructure, formal recognition, and the systemic conditions needed to ensure food safety. This results in Indian street food being widely perceived as unhygienic - which comes as a consequence of the infrastructure deficit they operate within.

Adapting the Singaporean Hawker Centre Model for India

Field Project Focus

A transformative approach is needed to create a hygienic, sustainable, and well-managed urban food ecosystem that preserves and celebrates India's rich street food culture.

In partnership with the **World Toilet Organization**, the project will explore innovative pathways to develop a scalable and financially viable model for modern urban food hubs that enhance public health, livelihoods, and urban liveability.

Participants Will Work On

- Designing an India-adapted Hawker Centre model that balances urban planning considerations with cultural preservation, economic inclusion, and the prioritisation of public health
- Developing sustainable operational and governance frameworks to implement hygiene and quality standards, vendor transition strategies, stall management and oversight, and digital integration wherever applicable
- Laying out pathways for implementation and scale-up, including policy alignment, leveraging public and private partnerships, and adaptation across different Indian cities

This project addresses a pressing food safety challenge by examining how infrastructure, governance, and public policy can work together to formalise and positively transform one of India's most lucrative informal sectors.

Participants will engage with real-world constraints while developing human-centred solutions that improve food safety, strengthen livelihoods, enhance urban resilience, and elevate India's street food culture as a source of national pride and global recognition.
