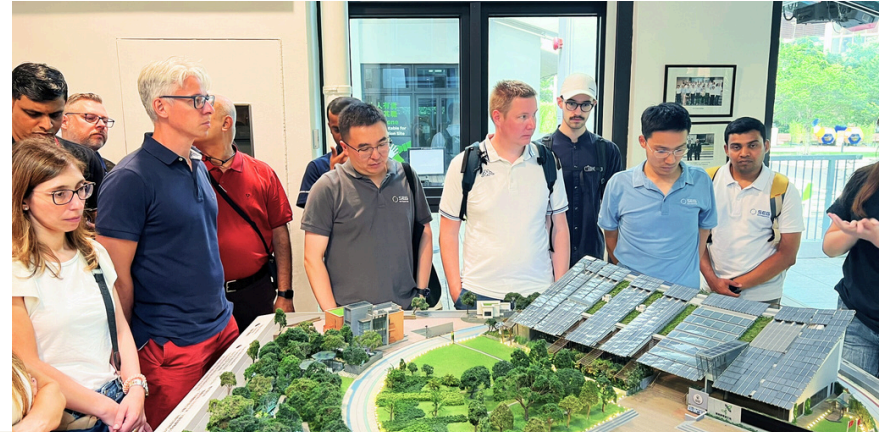

Project Focus:

A sustainable model to build solar-powered well and pumping systems for boarding houses in Iloilo City to improve water reliability during power outages and climate disruptions, lower long-term operating costs for property owners, and enhance daily living conditions for residents.

What Participants Will Work On:

- Operational feasibility of decentralised solar systems
- Economic viability and phased expansion potential
- Maintenance and skills requirements
- Workforce implications and local upskilling opportunities

This project links renewable energy transition directly to water security, housing resilience, and jobs. Participants engage with local stakeholders, infrastructure realities, and trade-offs, developing practical insights into how integrated, human-centred solutions can strengthen urban resilience in climate-vulnerable contexts.

Why The Philippines?

- 35% Shift to renewable energy sources by 2030¹
- 100% Renewable energy sector opened to foreign ownership²
- \$23bn Renewable Energy investment in 2024

The Philippines faces challenges in expanding its power grid due to its archipelagic geography, high climate risk causing frequent disruptions, and issues like high upfront costs, slow permitting, and limited community engagement that hinder decentralised energy solutions.
